The goal of H.O.P.E.'s grant program is to enable supplementary financial support to Heyworth Elementary staff for the end benefit of student education/enrichment. 1. Describe the proposed need/project/program and the objectives it would accomplish.

I am applying for an entire year bundle of math centers (a total of 90 centers) to reinforce third grade math skills, as well as challenge higher level learners during our Math Rtl time . Our Math Rtl block is new this year and I do not have enough resources to utilize during this time. My students enjoy playing learning games. I have also found that learning games allow for social interaction and problem solving with peers, which are also valuable common core state standard skills.

I am also applying for 10 wobble seats for my classroom. Each year, I have students that benefit from using a wobble seat. These seats allow students to move without distracting others in the class. I'd like to give students the option to use one if they feel it would be beneficial for them during instruction and work time. Having 10 wobble seats and giving students an option would not single any students out. This is why I would like to get 10 wobble seats and not an entire class set.

I would also like to get a classroom set (25) of clipboards. Clipboards are useful for students when they work around the room. This way, they do not have to write on a surface like the carpet, the floor or their lap. I like to offer movement around the room when applicable so that students are not stuck sitting in one place for an extended period of time.
