## H.O.P.E. Grant – Application Detail Form

The goal of H.O.P.E.'s grant program is to enable supplementary financial support to Heyworth Elementary staff for the end benefit of student education/enrichment. The below questions should be completed to provide a more detailed description of the grant request. The application form should not exceed one typed page. 1. Describe the proposed need/project/program and the objectives it would accomplish.

Last year HOPE generously accepted my application to purchase a new curriculum for 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade music. This curriculum is used daily and is very well received by our students. I would like to supplement this by extending the curriculum, visuals and resources, and storybooks to 1<sup>st</sup> grade music classes, giving visual/digital resources to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade classes, and purchasing GameBoard, which is a set of posters, manipulatives, charts, and other helpful visuals that spans all grade levels. This would complete the set that I currently have and works so well. Last year 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade was the most in need of a new curriculum, and the grant would only cover the purchasing of materials for these grades. I would like to complete the curriculum this year.

2. What is the estimated cost of the project/program? Please summarize and attach itemized list.

The cost of the final supplements would be a little less than \$1,500. I am asking for \$1,500 to cover shipping and any additional cost. I do not anticipate needed more than \$1,432 but want to be safe. I have dealt with the supplier last year, and they easily accepted our tax free form.

3. Who and how many would benefit from this project/program? What would be the impact on students/staff?

The target audience is 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, about 130 students, and all grades will be impacted by the GameBoard resource set. The second grade would have their own set of manipulatives, rhythm cards, posters that coincide with lessons and songs from their curriculum, and digital resources to supplement their curriculum. First grade would receive an entire different curriculum. Currently Kindergarten and First grades are taught from the same curriculum book that I have purchased myself, and they need a slightly more advanced method of learning music. They would receive new lessons, visuals, storybooks, and digital content for their music classes. The GameBoard set includes instrument charts and visuals to teach from before playing begins, a changeable solfege ladder, body percussion staff, musical symbol

flashcards, instrument symbol flash cards, and many more physical and digital resources for our students. These are designed to span across all grade levels, 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> who currently use the GamePlan curriculum.

Students in first grade would receive a more challenging and appropriate curriculum for their age level, while 2<sup>nd</sup> grade would receive the supplements 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade currently enjoy with the visual and digital resources. First and Second graders will find more success in music class with appropriate instruction and visuals to aid in their learning. All grades will find many aspects of music easier to comprehend with additional resources and visuals to aid in their experience that they do not currently have.
